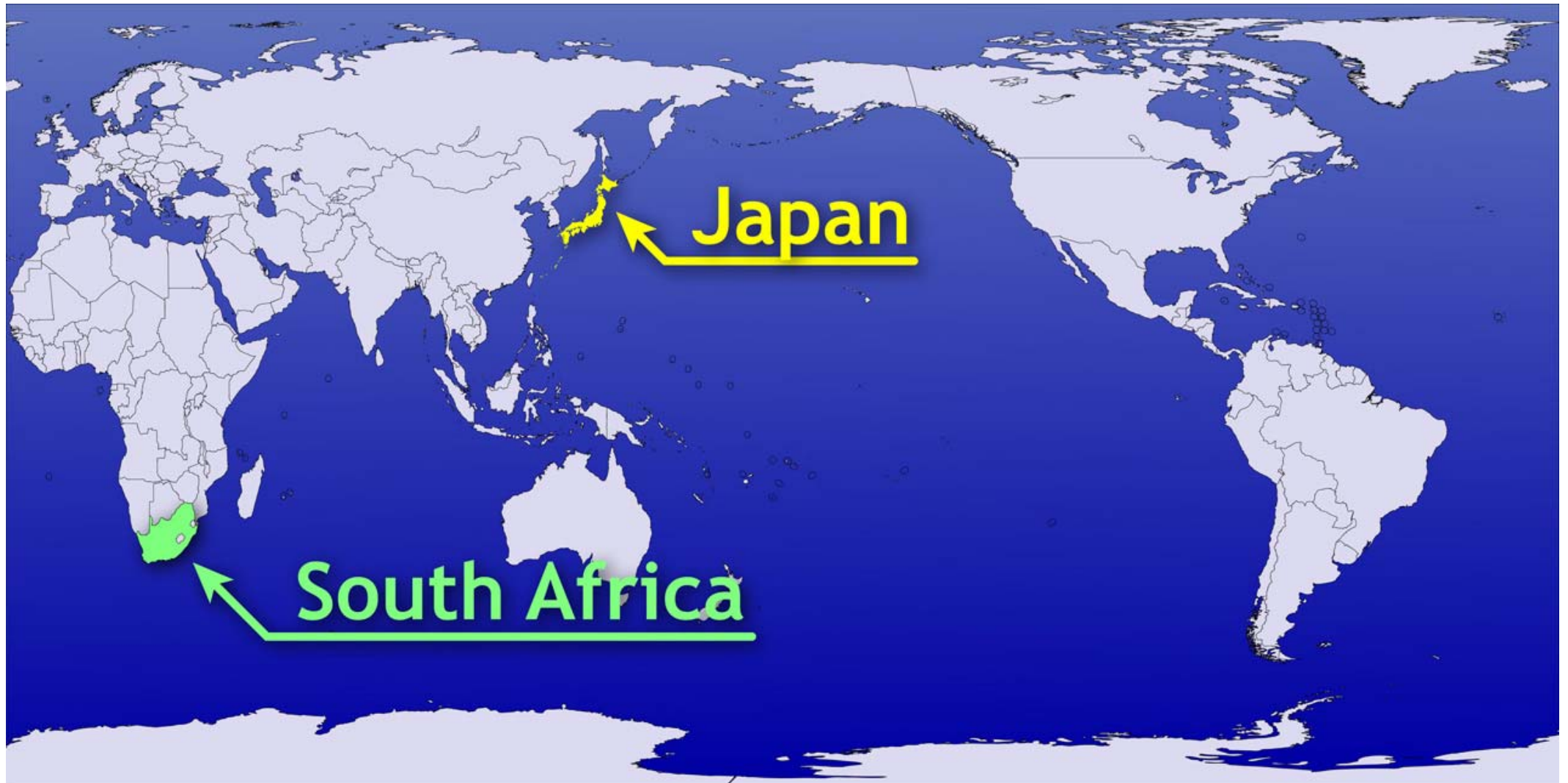

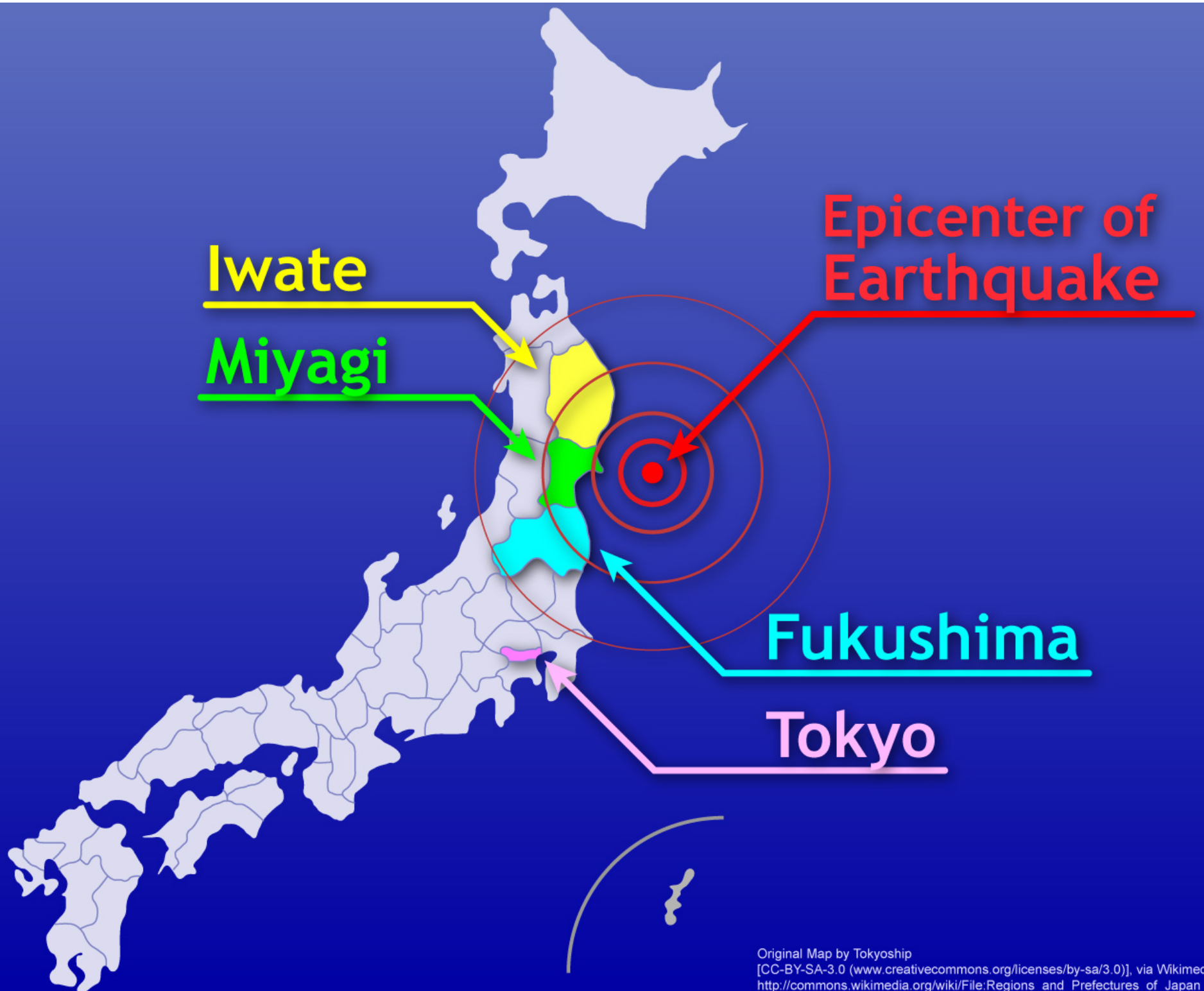
Location of Japan

Evacuation Status

- Fukushima Prefecture
 - A) 2 in the evacuation center in Fukushima Pref., 4 in temporary housing
 - B) 1 in the evacuation center outside Fukushima Pref.
 - C) 1 to be escaped following the evacuation plan
- Depending on the situation of Fukushima No.1 Nuclear Power Plant, the number of evacuee may increase due to expansion of evacuation area.
- Miyagi Prefecture
 - 2 in 2 different evacuation centers , 29 in temporary housing

- April 9-18, 2011

Sent 4 members of the Psychological care team to Miyagi, conducted survey and consultation

- April 22-25, 2011

Psychological care team conducted the first assessment survey, interviewed 57 persons.

- May 2-5, 2011

Mr. Ishino, Chief, and Mr. Nakamura, Manager, visited the headquarters of the 3 prefectures and devastated area, encouraged sufferers.



May 12, 2011

The 2nd meeting of the Central Headquarters was held

- May 27-June 7, 2011

The total of 10 members of the psychological care team conducted the 2nd assessment survey, interviewed 64 persons.

- May 28-29, 2011

Delivered relief supplies to Iwate Regional Headquarters.

Coordinated assistance with Miyagi Regional Headquarters.

- July 1-5, 2011

Mr. Hisamatsu, General Manager and Ms. Asai, Coordinator of Sign Interpreting, visited Regional Headquarters of Iwate and Miyagi and the devastated area, negotiated with the prefectural government of Iwate and Miyagi, and talked about the future.
